Project Advance is underway!

Reaction to our unusual Project Advance banner is exactly what we hoped for! Even Fr. Giovanni has weighed in with his critical comments!

We wanted to remind people that our campaign may be annual, but it's not routine. Every year, we face a challenge to enlist new donors and to get the message out that our Archdiocese and our parish depends on your generosity with Project Advance.

In his homily last Sunday, Msgr. Smith announced that "Make Sundays Matter" was this year's theme. Many of the projects are connected to making Mass meaningful for parishioners and visitors alike.

The single largest project, repaving of the plaza in front of the church, addresses sinking pavement that could not be successfully fixed by other means, despite efforts several years back.

Another major parish initiative supported by this year's campaign will be the installation of video projection equipment and screens. This was a 2017 Project Advance venture that proved more expensive than expected; it will receive additional funds this year.

Once the parish has met our Archdiocesan goal of \$69,000, the remaining funds will go back to Christ the Redeemer to assist the projects listed below:

- New stairs and pavement at the front of the church
- Added funding for video projection project
- Improvements to choir loft sound system
- Mass Guides to assist our visitors
- Prison Ministry
- Society of St. Vincent de Paul
- Outreach to neighbours
- Evangelization and Growth programs
- New cooler for Large Kitchen




Fr. Giovanni thanks all of you who came to the Gala Dinner and also those who supported the seminary by donating. It was a great night filled with joy and the Holy
